  - Lesson Learned: In the future we need to use another system such as Event Bright for the all league banquet. Main issue is people are trying to purchase multiple tickets and are unable to.

#### Secretary's Report:

- Old Business:
  - The Board of Director term sheet needs to be updated with Officers, Directors, and Commissioners.
  - Looked over Secretaries duties in bylaws, noticed I have not been adding these minutes on the website, and wanted to verify that this is being done. 6.4.7 Each Committee or Athletic Commissioner MUST hold monthly meetings during their leagues operating months regarding its performance in carrying out league divisional activities and give notice of meetings to all league registered members and registered non-members at least one(1) month in advance. Meeting minutes must be submitted to SEPSA's Secretary immediately following each meeting to be made available on SEPSA's website.
  - Reviewed the Kickball Athletic code. Noticed some errors. Do we need to amend to fix grammatical errors?
    - 1.1 Sioux Empire Pride Sports Association-Kickball (Sioux Empire PSA-kickball) is a non-profit adult community-based sports organization created to support the bonds of Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, and Transgendered (LGBT) fellowship to play softball in a safe environment of friendly competition; free of discrimination based on age, race, creed, religion, sex, national origin, sexual orientation, gender identity or playing ability.
    - 5.6 A team must have a minimum of twelve (6) roster players to borrow two (2) players from another team to field a team for play, 6.10 Players can throw the ball to get a runner out, but absolutely shots above the shoulders. Needs clarification.
    - 9.1-9.3 Alcohol (NO GLASS) is allowed within the guidelines of the Sioux Falls Parks and Rec. Individuals that are intoxicated will be removed from gameplay. Players with multiple offenses may be removed from Sioux Empire PSA-Softball for the remainder of the season.
    - Players who appear to be under the influence will be removed from gameplay immediately as they endanger themselves and others. Players with multiple offenses may be removed from Sioux Empire PSA-Softball for the remainder of the season.

- Violating the Sioux Empire PSA-Softball mission statement or demonstrating unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated. Players in violation may face immediate removal from the game and Sioux Empire PSA-Softball for the remainder of the season.
- 8/27 Game, one team did not have enough players so we made them take an out at the bottom of their lineup. I now noticed this is not in the athletic code. Do we want to add this rule, or always forfeit?

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#### New Business:

- Update on Racing. First Moto of the season, May 20th, 2023, I wrecked pretty bad but finished 2nd for the night. 2nd and 3rd Moto of the season I finished 4th in all 3 entered classes. Due to unforeseen circumstances, I am unable to finish out the South Dakota season. However, one of the biggest races of my career is taking place September 16th and 17th. I am racing against men and women across the country in New Ulm, MN. These races are only put on twice a year. I have been training and preparing for this track all summer.
- Never Give Up Coaching & Life Skills Group 81 (NGU81) would like to follow up on the discussion of adding basketball to our league. I know there has been a lot of interest just through word of mouth, however, we would like to attempt this by hosting a soft 3v3 or 5v5 tournament. This is definitely up for discussion, as we want to make sure we have enough teams interested prior to starting another league. A very rough draft of the potential rules we would follow can be found here CoEd Rules.docx. Since the school district took over all of the community centers, they are now in charge of renting those out. They require a 1 million dollar insurance policy to even rent the space. I have inquired with Linwood Wesleyan about renting their facility for NGU81's regular weekly practices, and I am sure we could accommodate additional dates/times for this tournament. They have strict dates/times available, require a \$500 damage deposit (returned if no damages occur) and \$50/hour. Keep in mind that 3v3 and 5v5 games are very different. 3v3 play only to 21pts or 15 minutes. We could have 4 games going on at the same time because they only use half the court.
